COURSE STRUCTURE:

The two-day weekend intensive course is designed to prepare the candidate who is going to sit for the MRCOG Part 1 Examination soon. It is a revision course and the candidates are expected to have done some reading before coming for the course.

The whole syllabus cannot be covered given the short time available. However the topics have been carefully chosen in order to cover the areas from which the bulk of the questions are being or have been asked as according to the guidelines as set by the Royal College namely Anatomy, Biochemistry, Embryology, Endocrinology, Epidemiology/Statistics, Genetics and Physiology for Paper One and Biophysics, Clinical Management, Data Interpretation, Immunology, Microbiology, Pathology and Pharmacology for Paper Two.

Each topic will start with an interactive lecture that will cover the "must know" knowledge that the candidate must have before he sits for the Examination. This will be followed by ample practice with single best answer (SBAs) questions on the topics lectured to test his knowledge. At the end of the Course the candidate will be in a very good position to sit for the examination.
