The purpose of the workshop is to guide the student on how best to do and submit a research study as required under the parallel pathway programme guidelines. There will be two parts.

The first part involves guiding the student on the most appropriate kinds of study he should embark on – given the constraints of time and his clinical commitments e.g. cross-sectional studies, case control studies, evaluating a diagnostic test, etc. The nature of the study, the method of collecting the data and their advantages and disadvantages of each study design will be covered. It will start with the research question, its hypothesis testing and he or she will be guided on the best way to collect the data but with the idea of its presentation and analysis in mind, including, how to estimate the sample size needed. The session will end with a guide on how to do a literature review using Endnote – an indispensable guide.

The second part of the workshop will involve breakout sessions where each group will be given a research question and they will have to plan and present a proposal for the research question given, utilizing the knowledge and guidance provided earlier.

Professor Kulenthran graduated from the University of Singapore in 1975. He had an interest in Obstetrics and Gynaecology and went on to obtain his MRCOG in 1982. He then joined the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, University of Malaya the following year as a Lecturer. He rose through the ranks and was appointed full Professor in 1991. He was elevated to a Fellow of the Royal College in 1992. He has the rare distinction of a clinician holding two doctoral degrees, the MD and PhD from the University of Malaya. Having found his niche in research methodology, he moved to the Medical Education and Research Development Unit of the Faculty in 2007 to teach young academicians in Research Methodology Publication. He is a trained epidemiologist and statistician having read the Postgraduate Diploma in Epidemiology and a Certification in Advanced Statistical Analysis in Epidemiology from the London School of Hygiene. He speaks regularly on clinical epidemiology, statistics and medical writing courses and workshops both within and out-with the Faculty and hence well equipped to talk on the subject, knowledge and guidance provided earlier.
