- 1. Abstracts must be submitted in English. Recommended font size is Times New Roman, size 12.

- 3. The maximum number of words should not exceed 300. Do not include graphs, tables, images or references in the abstract.
- 4. There is only one mode of presentation.
- 5. A confirmatory email will be sent to successful candidates, and authors will be notified before 15th January 2026.
- 6. Once accepted, the registration fee has to be paid by 25th January 2026.
